**Design Division – Rules and Regulations**

1. Classes are open to all interested exhibitors, membership not required to enter. One entry per exhibitor per design class.
2. Design entries can be placed on Friday, July 05<sup>th</sup> between 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and on Saturday, July 06<sup>th</sup> between 7:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m.
3. All designers must leave the show areas by 10:30 a.m. Saturday, July 06<sup>th</sup>. Judging will begin promptly at 11:00 a.m. Designs must be removed between 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 07<sup>th</sup>.
4. No one may move a design except the exhibitor.
5. All plant material must be kept in good condition for the duration of the show. The Show Committee reserves the right to change or remove wilting plant material.
6. All entries must be the work of the exhibitor.
7. Designs can be pre-done or in situ as space is limited.
8. Choice of pedestal in a class will be first come, first choice.
9. At least one (1) fresh lily (genus *Lilium*) must be included in each design. Any type of living, dried and/or preserved plant material may be used unless otherwise stated. For the Design Division, plant material may be from any source, except for wild plants, endangered or threatened species, which are forbidden.
10. The Show Committee will take reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of the exhibits, but the Society will not be held responsible for loss through theft or breakage.

**11. WAF A Rules for Design**

- a) An exhibit is made of plant materials, with or without accessories, within the space specified in the Show Schedule.
  - b) Plant material must predominate over all other components of the exhibit,
  - c) The use of artificial plant material is forbidden unless stated in the regulations.
  - d) Fresh plant material must be in water or water-retaining material unless such material remains turgid throughout the event i.e., some tropicals.
  - e) Painted and/or artificially coloured plant material may be used unless otherwise stated in the regulations.
12. All entries must be pre-registered by June 22nd, 2024. Early registration would be appreciated by contacting the convener for each class. If you have difficulty contacting the convener, then contact the Show Registrar.
13. In the event that you cannot meet your commitment, you must provide a replacement exhibitor and notify your convener prior to the show.
